DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION
THE DOSE OF BISOPROLOL FUMARATE MUST BE INDIVIDUALIZED TO THE NEEDS OF THE PATIENT.
THE USUAL STARTING DOSE IS 5 MG ONCE DAILY. IN SOME PATIENTS,
2.5 MG MAY BE AN APPROPRIATE STARTING DOSE (SEE BRONCHOSPASTIC DISEASE IN
WARNINGS). IF THE ANTIHYPERTENSIVE EFFECT OF 5 MG IS INADEQUATE,
THE DOSE MAY BE INCREASED TO 10 MG AND THEN, IF NECESSARY, TO 20 MG ONCE DAILY.
