LEEPRA[®] (LEVETIRACETAM) TABLETS IS
AN ANTIEPILEPTIC DRUG AVAILABLE AS 250 /500 /750 AND 1000 MG - ALSO XR.

Leepra[®] (Levetiracetam) Tablets is an anticonvulsant medication used to treat epilepsy. It is the S-enantiomer of etiracetam, structurally similar to the prototypical nootropic drug piracetam. Leepra[®] (Levetiracetam) has been approved in the European Union as a monotherapy treatment for epilepsy in the case of partial seizures, or as an adjunctive therapy for partial, myoclonic and tonic-clonic seizures.

It is also used in veterinary medicine for similar purposes.

Leepra[®] (Levetiracetam) has potential benefits for other psychiatric and neurologic conditions such as Tourette syndrome, autism, bipolar disorder and anxiety disorder,[3] as well as Alzheimer's disease. However, its most serious adverse effects are behavioral, and its benefit-risk ratio in these conditions is not well understood.

Along with other anticonvulsants like gabapentin, it is also sometimes used to treat neuropathic pain. It has not been found to be useful for essential tremors.
